

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Softail M8 Crash Bar "Task Force"

**NOTE:** Killer Custom assumes no responsibility or liability for damage or injury of any kind arising out of the use or misuse of any products.

- 1. Check all clearances before, during and after installation.
- 2. On the right ride:
  - Remove the footpeg mounting bracket by unscrewing the two bolts with a T45 Torx wrench.
  - Then, remove the brake bracket, which is secured with one bolt also using a T45 Torx wrench.



- 3. On the left side:
  - Remove the footpeg mounting bracket by unscrewing the two bolts with a T45 Torx wrench.
- 4. Mounting the Crash Bar:
  - Position the crash bar snugly against the motorcycle frame.
  - Using a 1-1/4" bolt and a 7/32" hex wrench, reattach the brake bracket through the crash bar and into the frame.
  - Reinstall both footpeg brackets using the four provided 2" bolts.
- 5. After the installation make a test drive to be sure everything is working perfectly.

## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

- Installation of this kit requires detailed knowledge of the motorcycle model and mechanics. It is assumed that the installer has access to the proper tools and a working knowledge of them and factory service manuals.
- Use medium-strength thread locker on all bolts.
- Don't worry if there's a small gap between parts it will close once the bolts are fully tightened.
